Scope of work, Deliverables and Evaluation Criteria is as under-

Scope of Work

- 1- The technical consultant shall hold the responsibility to design and develop a website in close coordination with MOJAZ Foundation's team on website development.
- 2- The Consultant shall hold overall responsibility in terms of work related to the development of website as per the quality standards/requirements of MOJAZ Foundation which includes
 - Designing of an interactive and dynamic website on the already existing domain, taking into account the requirements and standards including;
 - A back end for updating data on regular basis.
 - Clear catalogs & folders with an attractive page layout that is both user and administrator friendly.
 - Orientation to staff on website maintenance and content update
 - Security measures incorporated in the newly developed versions.
 - Support and maintenance service for 2019.
 - Make recommendations related to
 - Software, Hardware, and other back-end applications.
 - The back-up and restore plan of content already available on the website and
 - Back-up and restore plan in case of disasters linked with hacking and viruses.

Project Deliverables

The deliverables for the project includes

- 1- Functional Website with a functional Database Back End
- 2- Support and Maintenance for 2019

- 3- Technically averse website team for maintenance after service period ends which includes
 - Trainings of the team.
 - Technical understanding of making various maintenance related activities.
 - Giving on hand experience for back-up and restoration in case of web disasters.

Requirements for the Proposal

- 1- Consultant firm or individual must have NTN number.
- 2- Consultant firm or individual must be a reputable with prior rich experience in the field.
- 3- Proven and solid knowledge and experience in providing similar service able to provide user training and all documents in English.
- 4- Solid knowledge on website security and website hosting service.
- 5- The Vendor should provide a proposal that includes a brief implementation and risk mitigation plan.
- 6- The vendor should provide a detailed quotation including below information
 - Website design and setup.
 - Related software license.
 - Provide registered user interface softer for easy update and maintenance on regular basis.

All supporting documents, narrative and financial proposal must be part of the application and submitted/ uploaded as one document.

Roles and Responsibilities

The roles and responsibilities of Consultant(s)/firm are:

- 1- Consultant/Firm or individual will share detailed contents for website development.
- 2- Share sample web pages designs for approval after final selection of Consultant/Firm or individual for the assignment.
- 3- Share detailed technical narrative proposal including hardware and software requirement.
- 4- Financial proposal with budget breakup (Website designing, database and software (If applicable)).

Selection Criteria

Criteria for technical evaluation and obtainable score (Total 100) includes the following:

- 1- Relevant Education/Degree: 20
- 2- Relevant work Experience (Minimum 5 years):25
- 3- Experience in developing same quality website designing: 35
- 4- Price offer (Financial Proposal): 20

Best 3 of all the bids for the tender will be called upon for the prototypes exhibition. The criteria for scoring on the prototypes include:

- 1- Attractive Web Designing.

2- Comprehensive and Easy to use Nature of the Website
